

TRIAL SLEEVE

General information about Elements Body can be found on our website. The trial sleeve is intended to be used as an evaluation tool to establish if the patient can be helped by an Elements Body product or not. The trial sleeve can be used up to two weeks during evaluation, maximum 8 hours per day. The prescriber's recommendation should be followed.

According to the table, the sleeve can be used by maximum 10 patients in evaluation purpose.

The Trial Sleeve is intended to be used for assessment purposes only, prior to the provision of Elements Body garment. The Trial Sleeve is intended for short term use for a maximum of two weeks and is a useful assessment tool within the clinic setting..

Contraindications

The Trial Sleeve is intended to be used for assessment purposes only, prior the provision of an Elements Body garment.

Limitations

- Usage no longer than two weeks.
- The product can be used by up to 10 patients for evaluation, two-week usage per patient.
- The fitter is responsible for providing a clean and damage free product to the next user.
- Use the product chart for documentation.

Cautions

- Should not be used damp.
- Check garment and skin daily before usage.
- Product should be washed and examined between change of users.
- Should be washed twice a week for maintained function.

Polyamide, Elastane and Polyester
Anti-slip material in Thermoplastic Elastomer (latex-/silicone-free).

The fabric is certified according to standard 100 by Oeko-tex, class 2 and is GRS-certificated.
Contains recycled fibres.

The product is not flame retardant treated.

Washing Instructions

Machine wash at 40°C.

Disposal in accordance with local legislation.
